We are pleased to announce that we have a part-time Priest in Charge joining St Bertelina's Church.


His name is Danny Sedano.

photographer will be in school to take individual photos and photos with siblings. On this occasion, the photographers intend to start taking photographs from 9.00am onwards.


New parents, please be aware that you can bring in younger siblings who are not of school age to join their brothers and sisters for a photograph.

We expect the majority of our pupils to have an attendance figure of 97% or above, therefore holiday requests will be unauthorised.
