'Rules for Living - which rules should we follow?' in RE.

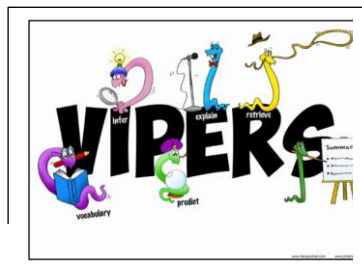
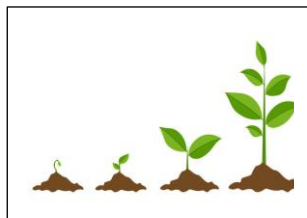
