### **Uniform**

Grey trousers/shorts/skirt/pinafore

White shirt/polo shirt

Black Shoes (not trainers)

Grey or red sweater/sweatshirt/cardigan

Red or grey tights/knee length white/grey socks

Red and white summer dress

School white T/shirt/plain white T shirt

White/black shorts

Pumps

Pump Bag

### **P.E Kit - Outdoor**

Trainers

Plain joggers/leggings

Plain sweatshirt/hoodie

Hair accessories should be minimalistic and in red/grey/black or white. Hair should be no shorter than a number 2. Jewellery is not allowed to be worn except for watches. Gold/Silver stud earrings can be worn in pierced ears (the child must be able to take these out by themselves for PE). All clothing must be clearly marked with the child's name.

Children are asked to wear indoor shoes in the school. These may be a separate pair of shoes brought from home, or a pair of pumps. Indoor shoes should be kept in school at all times. Infants should have pumps with elastic inset or Velcro fastening for ease of use. Swimming kit will be required at times for KS2 children.
