Perseverance

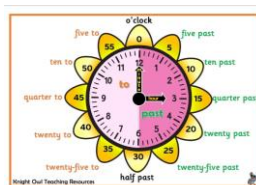
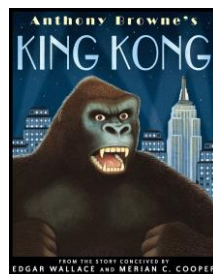
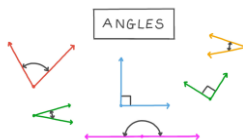
Your child's learning will be organised within this theme.
