HOPE


Your child's learning will be organised within this theme.

Your child's main areas of learning:

- > Our class novel is: Cool by Michael Morpurgo.
- ➤ In English, most of our learning this half-term will be based on the text Promise by Nicola Davies. In writing, we will focus on characterisation and learn how to use imagery to enhance our writing. We will also develop our diary writing skills using Little Freak by Ewin Schaap as a stimulus. Specific SPaG coverage includes: noun types, adjective, verb, adverb, parenthesis, relative clauses, dashes and modal verbs.
- ➤ In Maths we are focusing on the place value within numbers up to 1,000,000 (Y5) and 10,000,000 (Y6). Children will learn to add and subtract with larger numbers and also the rapid recall of all timetables, squared, cubed and prime numbers will be rehearsed.
- ➤ In Science, the children will be learning about looking after our environment
